

LOCAL QUALIFICATION DESCRIPTOR

Filosofie kandidatexamen med huvudområdet internationella relationer Degree of Bachelor of Science with a major in International Relations

1. Confirmation

A qualification descriptor for *Filosofie kandidatexamen med huvudområdet internationella relationer* at the University of Gothenburg was confirmed by the Faculty Board of Social Sciences on 30-03-2007, revised 14-06-2012 and 09-10-2014. The latest revision was confirmed by the Faculty Board of Social Sciences on 27-01-2022.

2. Qualitative targets

2.1 National outcomes

3. General scope of Degree of Bachelor

3.1 National rules pursuant to the Higher Education Ordinance

A Degree of Bachelor is awarded after the student has completed the courses required to gain 180 credits in a defined specialisation determined by each higher education institution itself, of which 90 credits are for progressively specialised study in the principal field (main field of study) of the study programme. A requirement for the award of a Degree of Bachelor is completion by the student of an independent project (degree project) of at least 15 credit sin the main field of study for the programme.

3.2 Local rules at the University of Gothenburg

A Degree of Bachelor should essentially include first-cycle courses, but may also include second-cycle courses if these are considered appropriate based on the requirements laid down in the qualification descriptors.

4. Scope of Filosofie kandidatexamen med huvudområdet internationella relationer

4.1 Scope

180 credits are required for this qualification, of which 90 credits should be in the main field of study. At least 15 of these 90 credits are to comprise an independent project (degree project).

4.2 Courses in the main field of study

Degree of Bachelor of Science with a major in International Relations includes core courses in international relations of 30 higher education credits, advanced courses in international relations of 30 higher education credits, an independent project (degree project) in international relations of 15 higher education credits.

Courses in the main field of study are met by courses or corresponding specified in appendix 1.

4.2 Courses outside the main field of study

In addition to the main field of study, any subject combination is required (within or outside the main area), up to 180 higher education credits.
